Female Empowerment

This workshop explores gender equality, human rights and social rights. Students examine the history and evolution of women's rights, assess global progress toward equality, and discuss barriers that persist today. It supports curriculum goals in ethical reasoning, intercultural competence and democratic participation by fostering understanding of inclusion, leadership and empowerment.

Current example: Students investigate abortion rights debates in the U.S., girls' access to education under Taliban rule in Afghanistan, and global gender pay gaps and leadership disparities.

Topics:

- Historical development of women's rights (19th century to present)
- Gender equality and discrimination across cultures
- Role of women in democratic and social movements
- Empowerment strategies and leadership
- Comparative study: nations supporting vs. restricting women's rights
